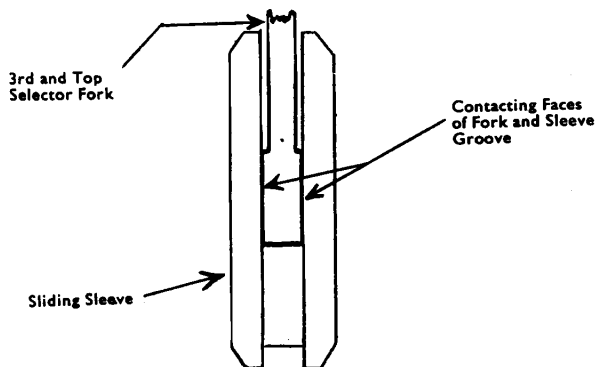


moved axially on the driving dog, thereby eliminating any tendency for the sliding sleeve to be incorrectly aligned when in full engagement with the gear dog teeth. The



increased width of the selector fork necessitates an increase in the width of the sliding sleeve groove, and the fork and sleeve are only interchangeable with the previous type in pairs.

From Engine No. EL/PD/20135 an adjustable gear change stay assembly Part Nos. J54497 RHD and J54506 LHD. was introduced. This adjustment makes it unnecessary to use force when fitting the stay to its location on the clutch housing.
